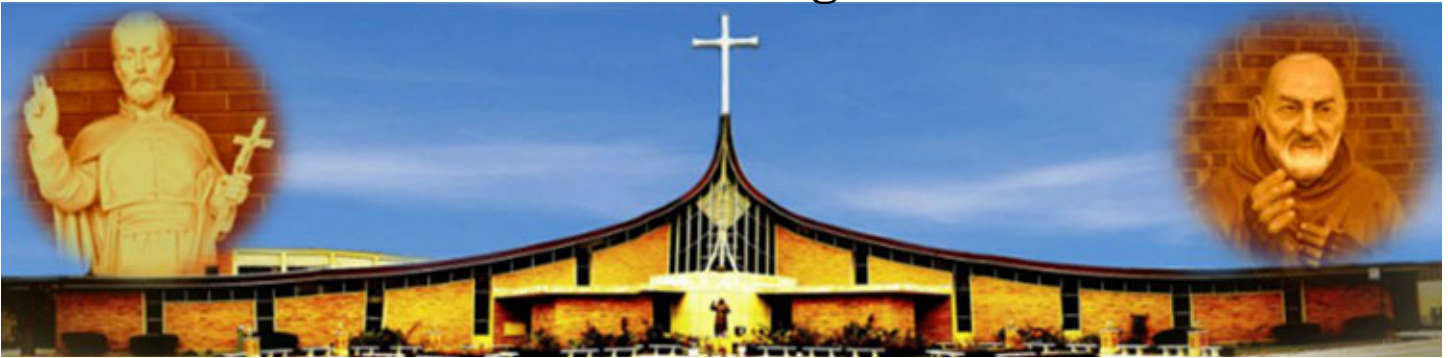

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

The RCIA, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, refers to a series of rites and faith formation for those who will be fully initiated into the Body of Christ, the Church. The adults in the RCIA program at St. Francis Borgia have been in formation since the fall and are completing their time of study and reflection. Those who are to be baptized are known as Catechumens and those who declare their intent to complete the Sacraments of Initiation or to be in full communion with the Church are called Candidates.

The Catechumens who are beginning their final preparation for the sacraments of Initiation- Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist-are Kendyl Fiorito and Jessica Orsan. The Candidate completing her Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist is Marilyn Cano and Candidate Christopher Douvris is to be received into full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. These RCIA Catechumens and Candidates were greeted by Bishop Alberto Rojas at Holy Name Cathedral, Sunday, March 1, for the Rite of Election and the Call to Continuing Conversion.

Candidates Jacqueline Gomez and Ysrael Gonzalez also have been preparing to be fully initiated through the Sacrament of Confirmation.

All of these individuals will be receiving the Sacraments at St. Francis Borgia at the Easter Vigil. Please pray for them during this most important time in their spiritual lives.

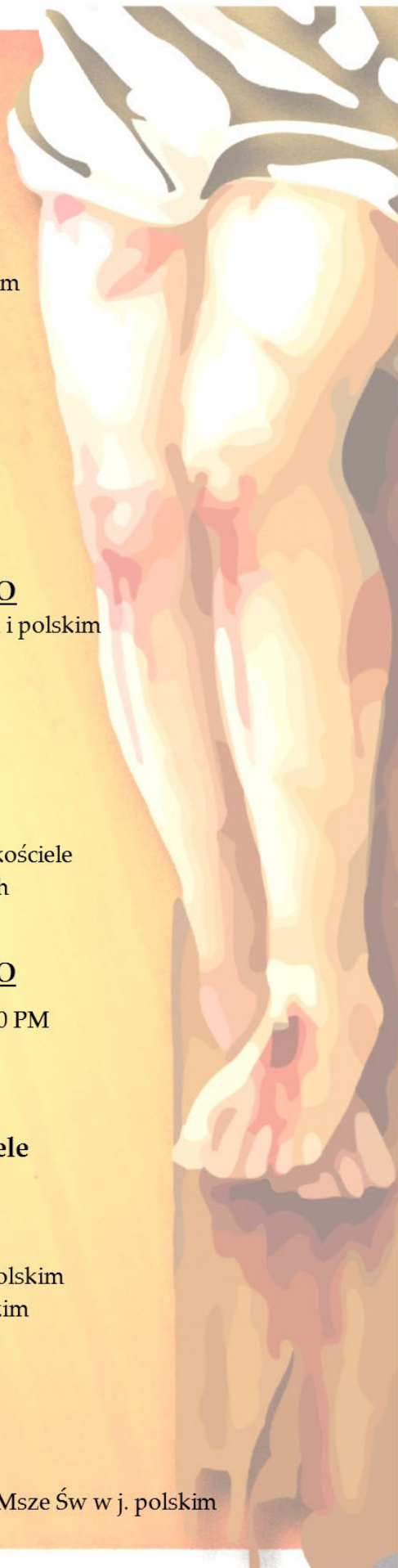

Z biurka Ks. Proboszcza...

Warta przy Grobie

Zbliża się Wielkanoc, jak co roku tak i w tym będziemy pełnić wartę przy Grobie Pana Jezusa. Rozpoczęcie Warty będzie po Liturgii Męki Pańskiej w Wielki Piątek około godziny 9:30 wieczorem.
