From the Pastor's Desk...

Today's readings certainly surprise us mentioning the people who murmured against God and His Son. It looks like the resistance was a human failing that can be witnessed from the beginning of time. The word „murmur” appears as many as nine times in the Bible and often in reference to Jesus and the Pharisees. It was they who criticized Jesus and His teaching behind His back as they were afraid of a confrontation with Truth. Compassionate and constructive criticism can be positive, helpful and sometimes even necessary. Murmuring does not help, but it unnecessarily divides. Most often, it is anonymous, since the complainant does not want to come forward.

Murmuring against Jesus can be heard today and is directed against His Church. Let us pray that today's Gospel be heard today and let it be a lesson against murmuring leading us into a truthful and responsible dialogue. One time I found a sign reading: „*A word can be more painful than a fist.*” Let us avoid needless murmuring, which can stop peace and harmony in any family including the parish one.

I want to thank those who came to the meeting regarding the renovation of our Church floor last Monday. There was no murmuring, just full understanding and support. Thank You!

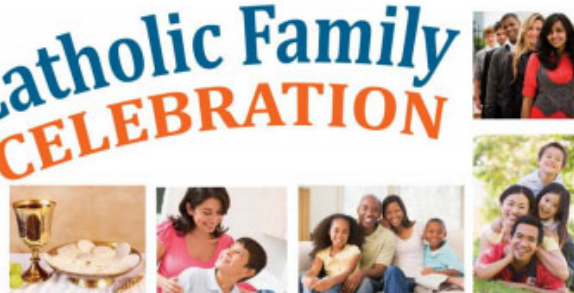

W dzisiejszych czytaniach zaskakuje nas z pewnością stwierdzenie, że Żydzi szemrali przeciwko Bogu. Zastanawiamy się jak ludzie mogli szemrać i przeciwstawiać się Bogu i Jego Synowi. Wygląda na to, że szemranie było ludzką cechą i słabością od samego początku istnienia świata i człowieka. To słowo pojawia się często w Piśmie Świętym w odniesieniu do Jezusa i faryzeuszy. To oni obmawiali i krytykowali Jego naukę poza Jego plecami, bo obawiali się konfrontacji z prawdą. Serdeczna i uzasadniona krytyka może być twórcza i pomocna a czasem jest wręcz konieczna. Szemranie natomiast nie buduje i łączy, lecz rozprasza i dzieli. Najczęściej jest anonimowe, bo brak mu odwagi i szczerości. Szemranie przeciw Jezusowi jest nadal słyszalne dzisiaj i jest skierowane przeciw Jego Kościołowi. Niech dzisiejsza Ewangelia będzie dla nas wyzwaniem do walki z szemraniem i lekcją wzywającą nas do prawdy i odpowiedzialności za każde nasze słowo. Kiedyś dojeżdżając do szkoły języka angielskiego kolejką widziałem następujący napis w środku wagonu: „*Słowo rani bardziej niż pięść.*” Nie pozwólmy, aby szemranie zniszczyło pokój i harmonię w jakiegokolwiek wspólnocie parafialnej lub rodzinnej.

Dziękujemy tym, którzy wzięli udział w spotkaniu dotyczącym renowacji posadzki w naszym Kościele w ubiegły poniedziałek. Nie było tam żadnego szemrania, wprost przeciwnie, tylko pełne zrozumienie i wsparcie przedstawionego projektu. Bóg zapłać!

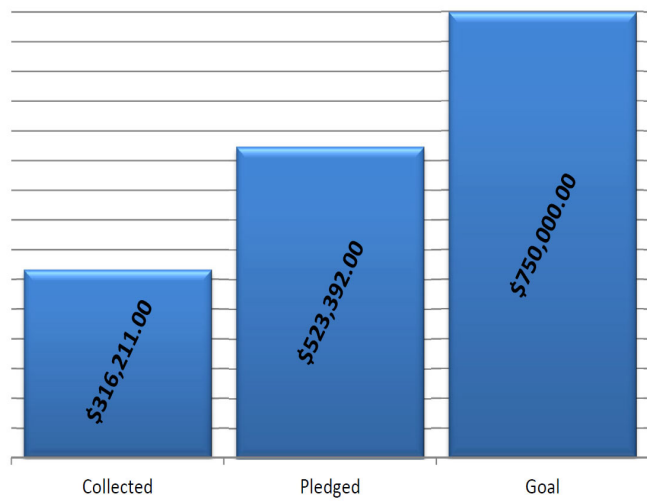

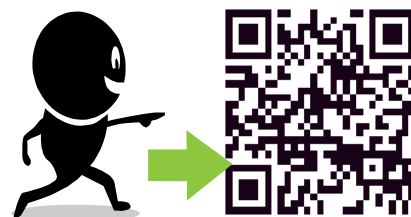
