In November of 2013, Pope Francis issued his Apostolic Exhortation called "The Joy of the Gospel." Nowadays efforts are made to deny them their human dignity and to do with them whatever one pleases, taking their lives and passing laws preventing anyone from standing in the way of this... Human beings are ends in themselves and never a means of resolving other problems... Once this conviction disappears, so do solid and lasting foundations for the defense of human rights... It is not "progressive" to try to resolve problems by eliminating a human life." Together with Pope Francis, let us defend life!

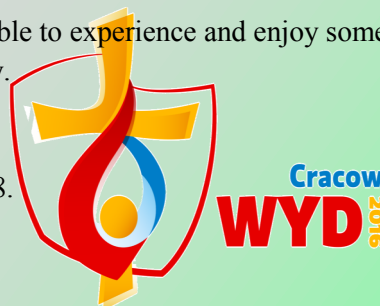


World Youth Day 2016

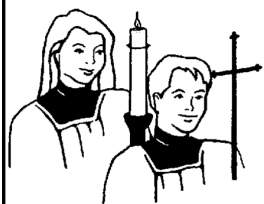

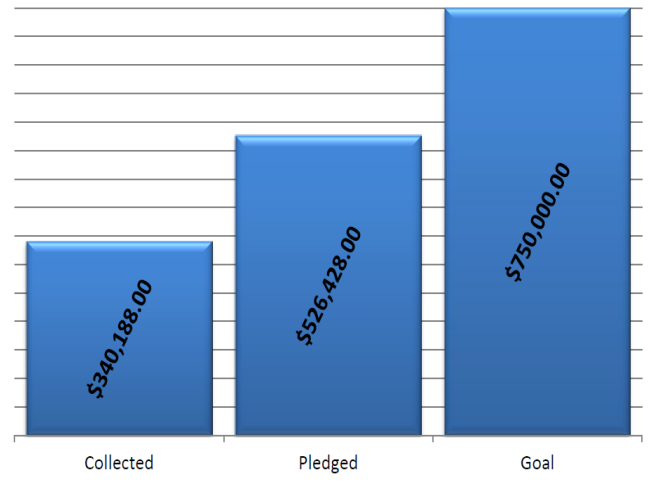

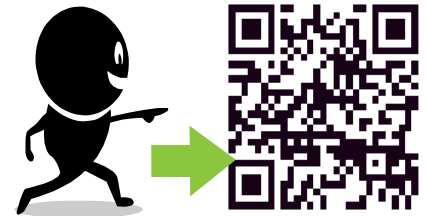
