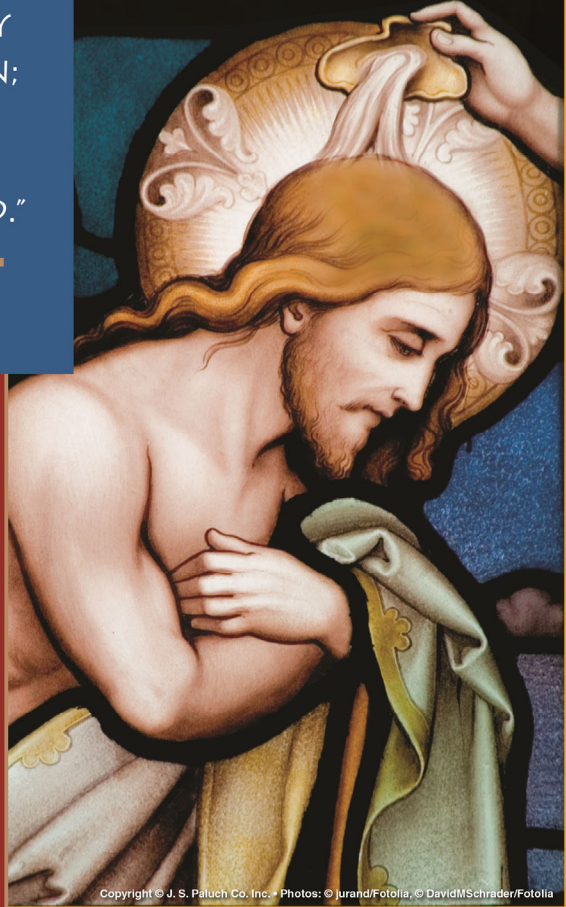

A word from the Associate Pastor...

After the sad news on Saturday afternoon of the death of our Father Rich's mother, Teresa, we continue to pray for Fr. Rich and his family during this time of sadness and grief. We also pray for our sister, Teresa. We pray for our deceased loved ones because we believe in the power of prayer and the Resurrection. We believe that our continual request to God to bring our loved ones to peace will prepare them to bear the fullness of His Love in heaven, but at the same can bring healing and consolation to those who mourn their beloved.

Eternal rest grant unto her, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon her. May she rest in peace. May her soul, and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

We still don't know when the special Memorial Mass for Teresa Milek will take place in our Church, but we will plan something when Fr. Rich returns.

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of Baptism of the Lord. Even though it is an event that took place roughly 30 years after Jesus' birth and the coming of the Magi, it is a feast that fits with the theme of Epiphany. In the Baptism of Jesus, God revealed that baptism is much more than water cleansing and purifications. It is a birth place in which the recipient is born again into the family of God through the Holy Spirit. This celebration marks a turning point in the Church's Liturgical Calendar because today we end the Christmas season and tomorrow we begin Ordinary Time.

There is a custom in many places in the Catholic world to keep the Nativity and some of the Christmas trees up in churches and homes until February 2, the Solemnity of the Presentation of Our Lord in the Temple. I googled to see if it's ok to keep decorations up, and there were different answers. I think the best was that "*the Vatican traditionally leaves its Christmas tree and Nativity scene in St. Peter's Square until the February 2 feast of the Presentation*". *We love the Vatican and Pope Francis and we want to share in this custom too. After conversation with Fr. Rich before he left for Poland we decided that we will keep our Christmas decorations until Feb. 2. Let's us still rejoice in celebration at the Birth of our Savior.*

Many thanks to those who came and said goodbye to Fr. Marcin last weekend. Please continue to pray for him and his new ministry.

School News

This Week At St. Francis Borgia School
Week of January 12, 2015

There will be a Parents' Association meeting at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, January 12, in the Stokes Center.

Registration for siblings of children currently registered at St. Francis Borgia School will begin on Tuesday, January 13th. Any family having a child entering our school for the first time needs to come in, in person, and register. A parent must come in and register even if a child has older siblings presently enrolled. We will open enrollment to new families on January 25, 2015.

The class opening for any new incoming sibling will be held until January 23, 2015. If your registration (i.e. all required forms completed and paperwork turned in) has not been completed by this date, we cannot guarantee a spot for your child.

Your child's original birth certificate (including birth number) and baptismal certificate, as well as your Sunday church envelope number will be required at the time of registration. Copies of these documents will be made in the office. If the child is being registered for grades one through eight, copies of the child's most recent health form and report card are also required.

If you have already completed your re-registration form and paid the \$100.00 non-refundable registration fee, you just need to come to school with the required documents and complete the registration paperwork.

The re-registration form must be completed and the 2015-2016 registration fee must be paid before registration of another child will be accepted. No child will be added to the school roster until all requested materials have been provided. A space cannot be guaranteed for your child/ren unless registration/re-registration is complete before open

enrollment begins.

Children being registered for 3 year old Pre-School must be 3 years of age on or before September 1, 2015. Four year old Pre-Kindergarten students must be 4 years of age on or before September 1, 2015. Kindergarten students must be age 5 on or before September 1, 2015. We adhere strictly to the age requirements set by Illinois State Law; no exceptions will be made.

Set up for our annual eighth grade science fair will take place on Wednesday, January 14, in Mayall Hall. The science fair projects will be judged after school on Thursday, January 15, from 3:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. The science fair is open to outside visitors Thursday evening, January 15, from 7:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. This week of our science fair represents the culmination of many months and hours of research, writing, experiment trials, and very hard work. All are welcome to come Thursday evening and see the effort put into these projects. Great work eighth grade, and special thanks to their teachers Mrs. Testa and Mrs. Gallagher!

Report cards will be distributed on Thursday, January 15.

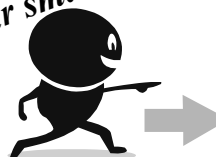
