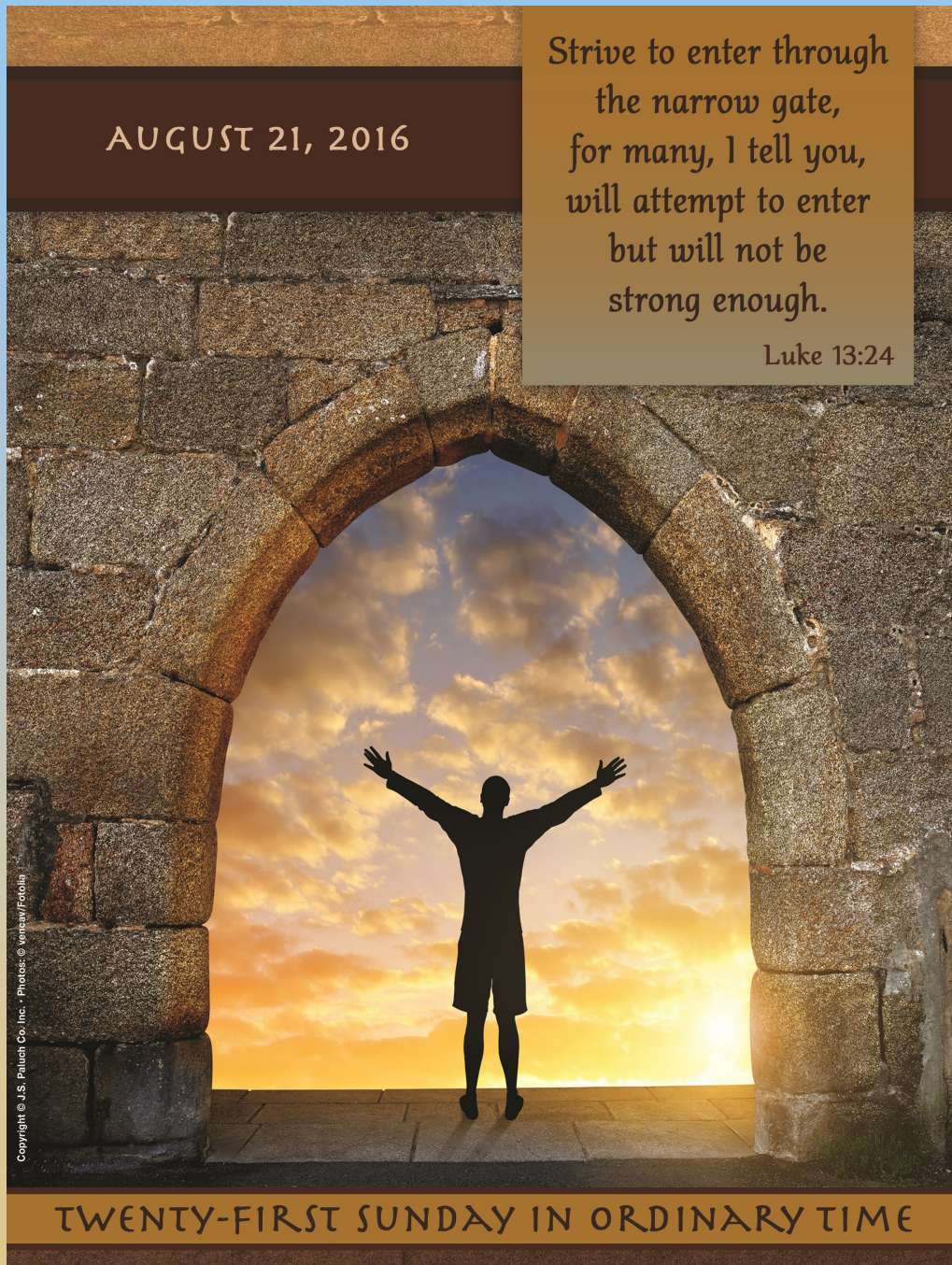

The registration fee after August 1, 2016, will increase to \$75 per child.

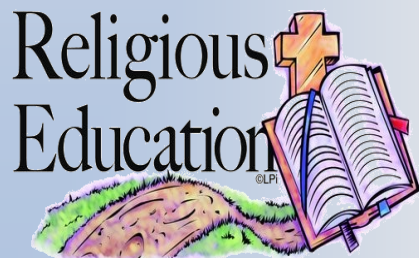

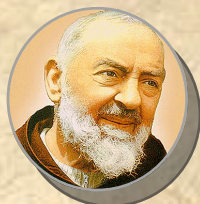

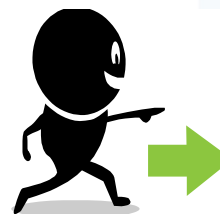
