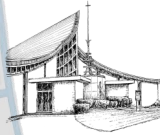
St. Francis Borgia Mission Statement

Sakrament Namaszczenia Chorych



Bardzo prosimy o zgłaszanie chorych, którzy nie mogą samodzielnie przychodzić do kościoła lub przebywają w szpitalu, do biura parafialnego. Księża nawiedzają chorych parafian z posługą sakramentalną. Zatem pora na przyjęcie tego sakramentu jest już wówczas, gdy wiernym zaczyna grozić niebezpieczeństwo śmierci z powodu choroby lub „starości”. Kościół naucza, że jest to sakrament umocnienia i uzdrowienia.
