

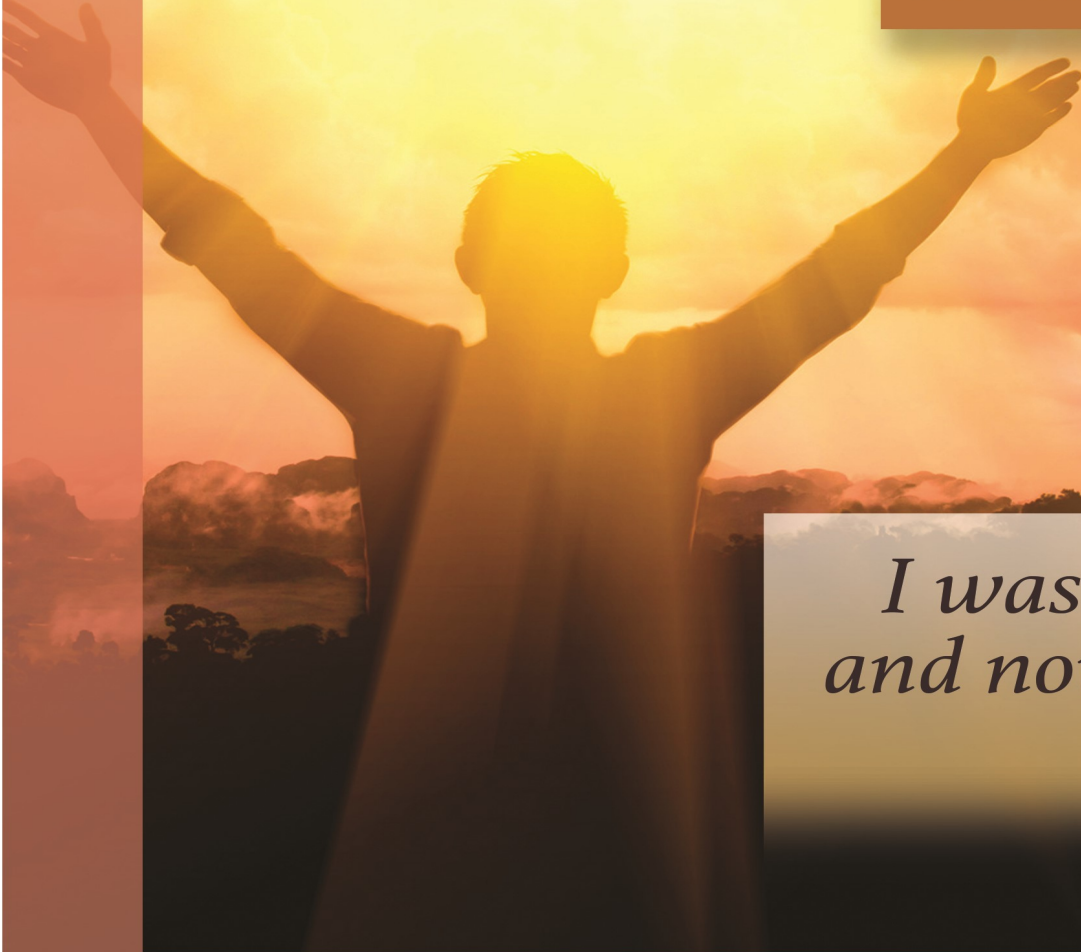

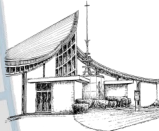
## St. Francis Borgia Mission Statement

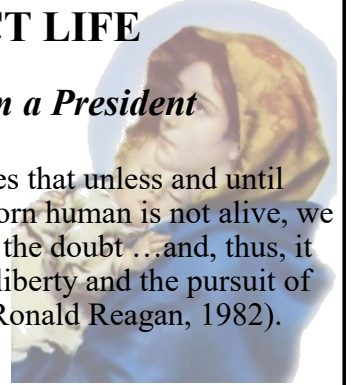

### Lenten Regulations

*(from March 1, 2017, Ash Wednesday, to the Paschal Triduum)*

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent. Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. The special Paschal fast, as well as abstinence, are prescribed for Good Friday and encouraged for Holy Saturday.

### ***From the Pastor's Desk...***

Last Sunday, we witnessed the beautiful and instructive dialogue between Jesus and the Samaritan woman. Today, we see Christ's touching encounter with the blind man, which concludes with a healing. The future occurrences of the blind man with the people aren't very joyful. The people, instead of being delighted for the man's happiness, they are questioning how it happened and why he was healed on the Sabbath. Not finding any sympathy from the people the healed man returns to Christ and thanks Him for the gift of sight and even more, for the gift of faith. Many times we feel like the blind man, unable to see a way out of the difficulties and problems that surround us.

I would like to invite and encourage you to participate in all the Masses, Stations of the Cross, Lenten Services, and the Retreat during this Lenten season. Fr. Joseph Mulcrone, the long time resident at St. Francis Borgia Church, will lead our Parish Mission this Lent from Monday, April 3rd through Wednesday, April 5th at 7:00 pm in the Church.

Thank you again for your generous pledges to the Annual Catholic Appeal. We are waiting for the official report from the Archdiocese, but it looks like we are going to reach and even exceed our goal. As I mentioned before, we are working on the new Church lighting, bell system, and sanctuary railings, and we would like to finish the parking lot project as well. Two weeks ago, together with representatives of the Finance Council, the Parish Council, and some other parishioners, we met with the Verdon Company, and we chose the new bell system that will be installed before Easter. We also met with Mr. Mike Lehman, who presented his new proposal for improving the lighting in our church and the electric panel. We agreed on the light fixtures that were presented to us, so the company will make a sample that we will try, and if it works, then we will order the rest of the light fixtures for the entire Church. Very soon we will meet with the Archdiocese and the company that will be doing the parking lot, and we will set up the time frame to finish the project. To make sure that we can finish these vital projects, following the idea of many parishioners, we will have an additional capital improvement envelope for these projects as a part of our next envelope package, as well as extra envelopes in the Church for those who are not registered in our Parish. I want to thank those who already gave their donation toward the new bell system project.

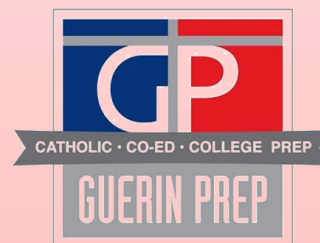

## Z Biurka Księdza Proboszcza...

W ubiegłą niedzielę byliśmy świadkami pięknego i pouczającego dialogu Jezusa z Samarytanką a dzisiaj widzimy niezwykle wzruszające spotkanie Chrystusa z niewidomym, które kończy się jego uzdrowieniem. Dalsze spotkania uzdrowionego z ludźmi nie są już tak radosne. Ludzie zamiast cieszyć się jego szczęściem, wszyscy dopytują się, jak się to stało i dlaczego został uzdrowiony w Święto Szabatu. 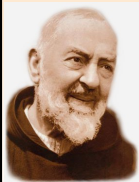
